

A WEEKEND WITH LIKE-MINDED ROTAX FLYIN 2021



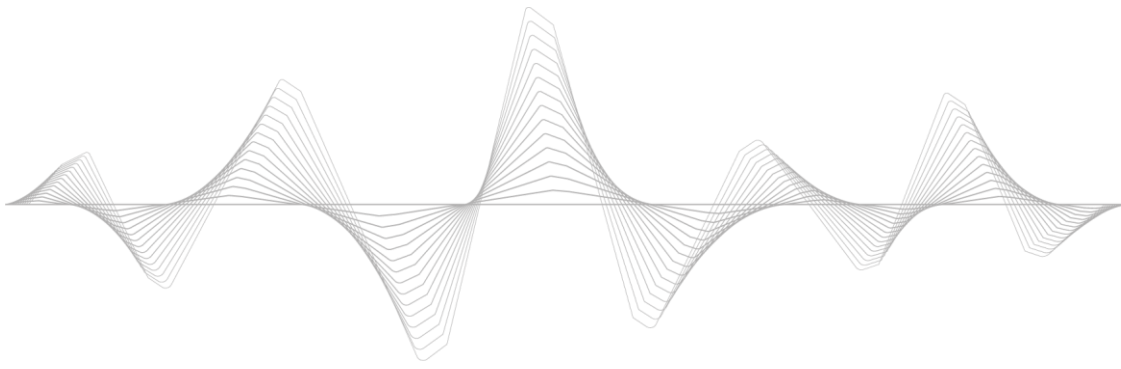

About 220 visitors came together to meet other pilots and flight enthusiasts from Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, France, Germany, Hungary, Italy, Lithuania, Luxemburg, Poland, Romania, Sweden, Switzerland, Slovakia and The Netherlands.

But not only the demo-flights were a highlight of the event, a lot of people also took the opportunity to visit BRP-Rotax in Gunskirchen for a company tour through the production facilities or got an adrenalin kick



booking the tandem-parachuting of the local skydiving school or competed at the flight simulator to win attractive prizes of the Rotax merchandise collection.

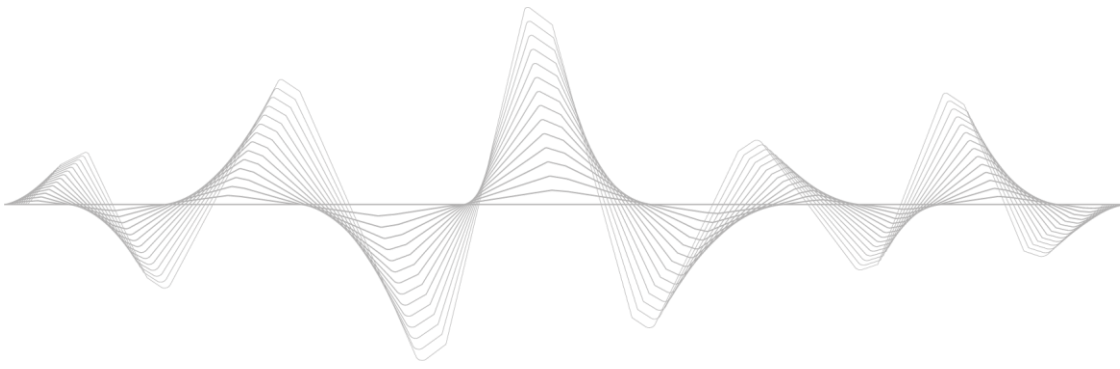
